Food and Non-Food Pantries

- Created notices to inform people of the closing of the food pantry on June 30th.
- Purchased items for non-food pantry.
- Organized/cleaned out closet for non-food pantry items.
- Met with Diane Gase and Barb and Chester Dowers for multiple conversations on organizing pantry and pantry use.

Summary: The Dowers will oversee non-food pantry and Diane Gase will monitor the stock of food needed on hand to complete emergency needs for food supplies as vetted through Pastor Joe. The three will support each other in both the non-food pantry and food stock. The items to purchase for the non-food pantry will be much more costly than the items we have been buying for the current food pantry. Chester is going to contact wholesalers to see if we can get some reduced prices. Tina Osso from Shared Harvest has said she would put us in contact with her wholesaler; however the amount we would need to buy of any item might prove to be a storage issue. The price she mentioned for TP through her wholesaler was 66 cents per package of 4 rolls.

- Mary Morris has agreed to start a card ministry for visitors and those absentees listed. I purchased cards and stamps for her to begin.
- The junior high and high school age will begin aluminum can crushing for Bob and Donna Cook so the Cooks can then take the aluminum to recycling.
- I updated the Missions Communication Board by the nursery.
- I purchased the hardware/frame for a large banner for roadside viewing.
- Met with Marlene Mang and Dowers for first use of non-food pantry by a Fairfield School Liaison.
- Working with Fred Guthrie and Bob Cook to promote CCC by enhancing the outside appearance through landscaping, painting of sign and flags.
- Attended VBS meeting.

- 60 cards were made by CCC women for new moms at Mercy in April.
- I took additional *Tale of Three Trees* books to the Mercy Obyn/Obstetric Clinic.
- More CCC T-shirts have been given out. Supply is almost depleted.
- Set up meeting with the representative of Elderly Services regarding use of non-food pantry.
- Sent checks for chosen External Tithe projects and contacted recipients.
- Called Covenant Mountain Mission Bible Camp twice to determine if the \$1,100 sent to them in December was received. No response/return phone call as of the writing of these notes.
- Collected craft materials for Dominican Republic Village Mountain Mission as requested.
- Read assigned chapter in *Emotionally Healthy Leader* for discussion at May Council meeting.
